

A short history of the Pheifer family from Friesland



Introduction

My father, Harke Pheifer (1920-2006) worked during his retirement for 15 years on the history of the Pheifer-family. As a child he had already been fascinated by the fact that he as a Frisian had such an unusual name. Harke did painstaking research in archives of churches and governments, went on many trips to the Hague or to Germany. He succeeded in making the family genealogical charts complete until 1599, even though there are many branches of family members who could not be traced. As a typical Frisian (always wanting to know who your parents are...) he also filled in the history of the Pheifer wives and their history as well as the Pheifer daughters, their partners and children.

I am Jack Pheifer (1950), Harke's youngest son. My father died in 2006 and recently my mother died, so now I am in possession of all their archives. The history laid down in these archives should not disappear in the future paperless society. So even though I will not continue his research, I aim to take care to safeguard all this information electronically on the Web, accessible to all Pheifer's or other families into which Pheifer daughters married, now and in the future.

The earliest version of the website was already online in 2005. But the amount of information was such, that I could only work periodically on extension. More than 800 people are described in the genealogical database.

Now, in the fall of 2013, I am ending the project by putting the information on a renewed website in the form of a booklet and picture albums, together with a full descendants-chart of Matthis Pfeiffer.

I publish the Pheifer records from Matthis (1599) up to and including the 12th generation (my generation). Each family member is then able to further keep his own records, as even the younger generations will still know where their (grand)parents came from! However if I had more information, I put it in the full chart, as the youngest 14th generation members are already growing up.

The present day Pheifer's can be described from 5 angles: the Pheifer's from Northern Friesland, Leeuwarden, Eindhoven, Groningen and Sneek in the Netherlands and the Pfeifers in the USA (most of them, as far as I know, have Leendert Pheifer (1851-1914) as their forefather). But there may be more Pfeifers: many males simply disappeared of the charts, and with our difficult name, their offspring may go under a lot of variations of our name.

I hope you will enjoy to have our joint history available on the net. History these here-and-now days is often seen as irrelevant, but let's not forget: all these people in the lists, made our lives today possible and we should be grateful for the life they gave us. I am grateful to them, that's why I did this job: to honor them.

1. Emigrating from Germany to Friesland

Somewhere around 1730 Daniël Pfeiffer, about 25 years old, said farewell to his father and left his birth town of Aschersleben in Eastern Germany. He was following his brother Christiany in migrating to the northern part of the Netherlands, called Friesland. He must have walked all the way, about 600 km, as he didn't come from a rich family.

About his brother we know little. The only civilian registers at that time were kept in churches. Churches recorded births, baptisms and weddings but only in a few cases deaths were recorded. Christiany was recorded in the register of the Dutch reformed church in Leeuwarden (the provincial capital of Friesland) as a member in 1724. At that time he was 27 years old. And this is the only information we have of him in the Netherlands.

We have to speculate why the brothers left their hometown in the prosperous region of 18th century Prussia. It is possible that they were trying to flee wartime circumstances as the emperor of Prussia, Frederick William I, was fashioning his state on a militaristic base, mobilizing all young men for the different wars with his neighbors.

Daniël was recorded in the church registers in Leeuwarden at the end of 1732. But about him we have no further information either. We know however he had a son, Johannes Daniëls, as this was recorded in the church registers of Sneek (Frld) at the end of 1752.

The letter s behind the second name signifies that Johannes was the son of Daniel. You will see these form in names all through the Frisian ancestors, as last names were only beginning to be registered in the early 1800's in the Napoleontic era.

Johannes registered as coming from a town near The Hague in the province of Holland. We don't know who his mother was and neither when his father died.

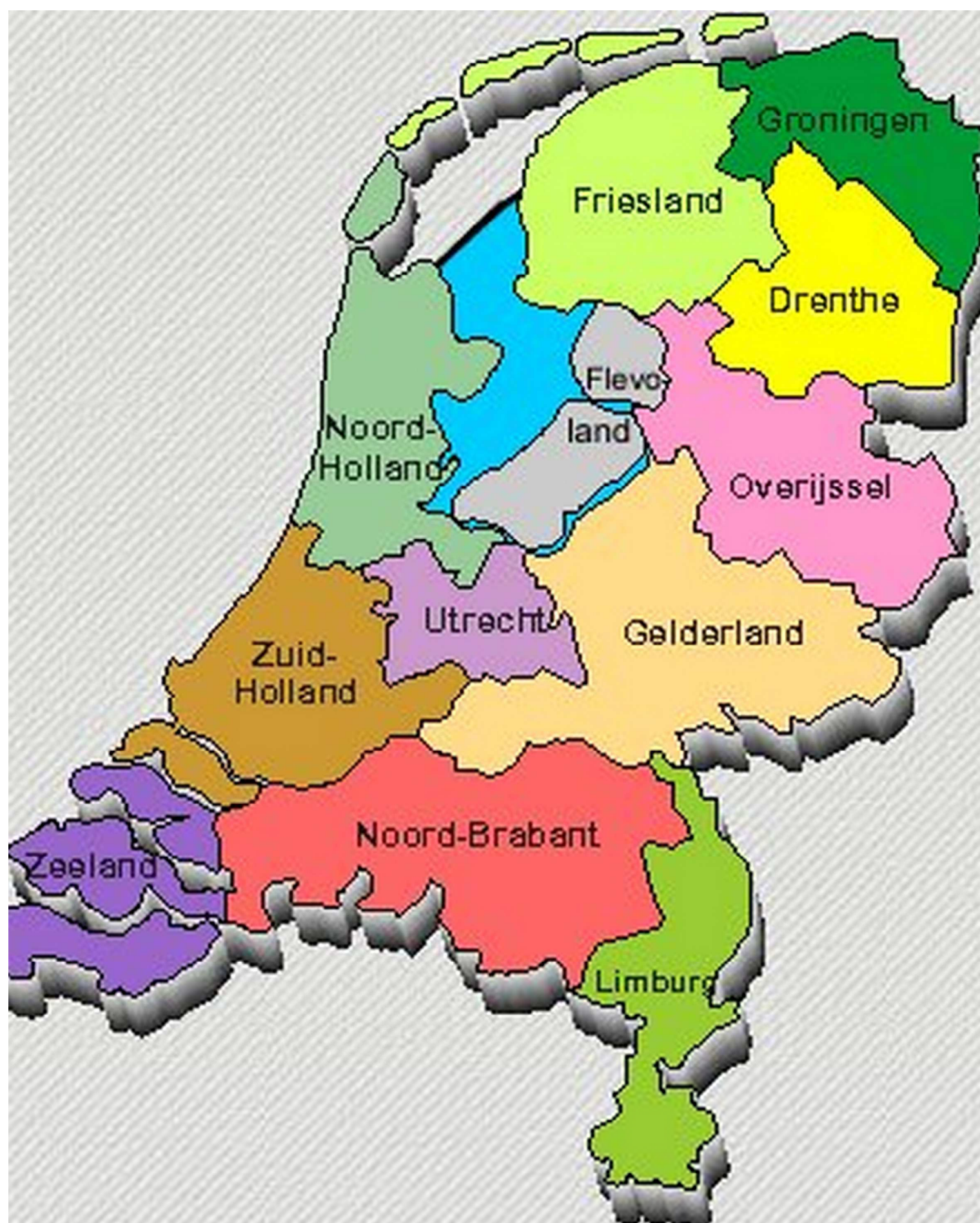
Johannes married Claaske Saackes, a prosperous farmer widow, in 1756. During his life he worked in different places in Friesland as gardener for aristocratic families.

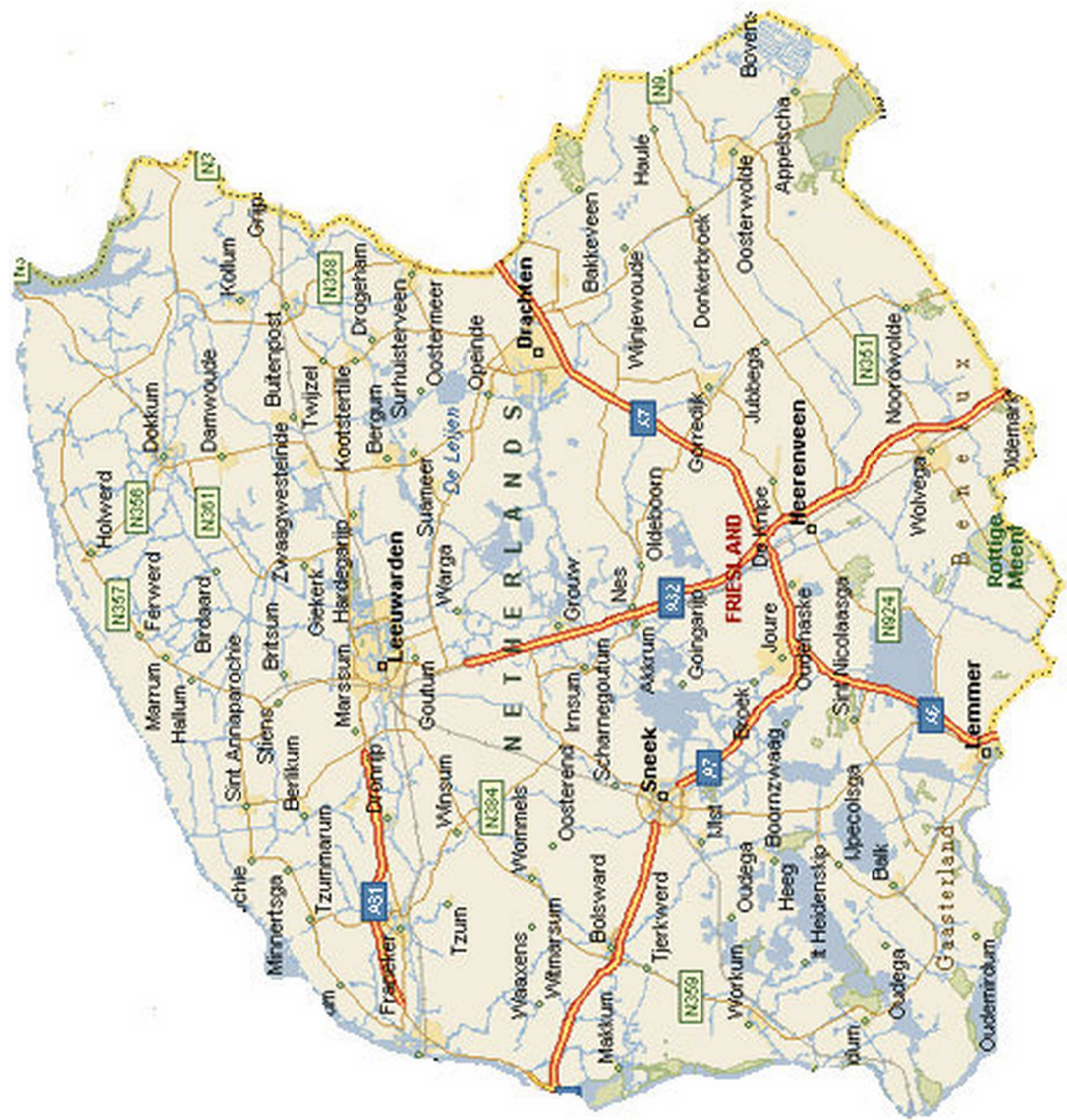
Johannes en Claaske had 7 children: Daniël, Rein, Lijsbert (only daughter), Pieter, Hendrik, Sjoerd and Marten. Of the 2 sons Hendrik and Marten we only have their date of birth. We have to assume they died at a young age. From Johannes en Claaske's offspring only Daniël's ancestorline was brought forward to these days.

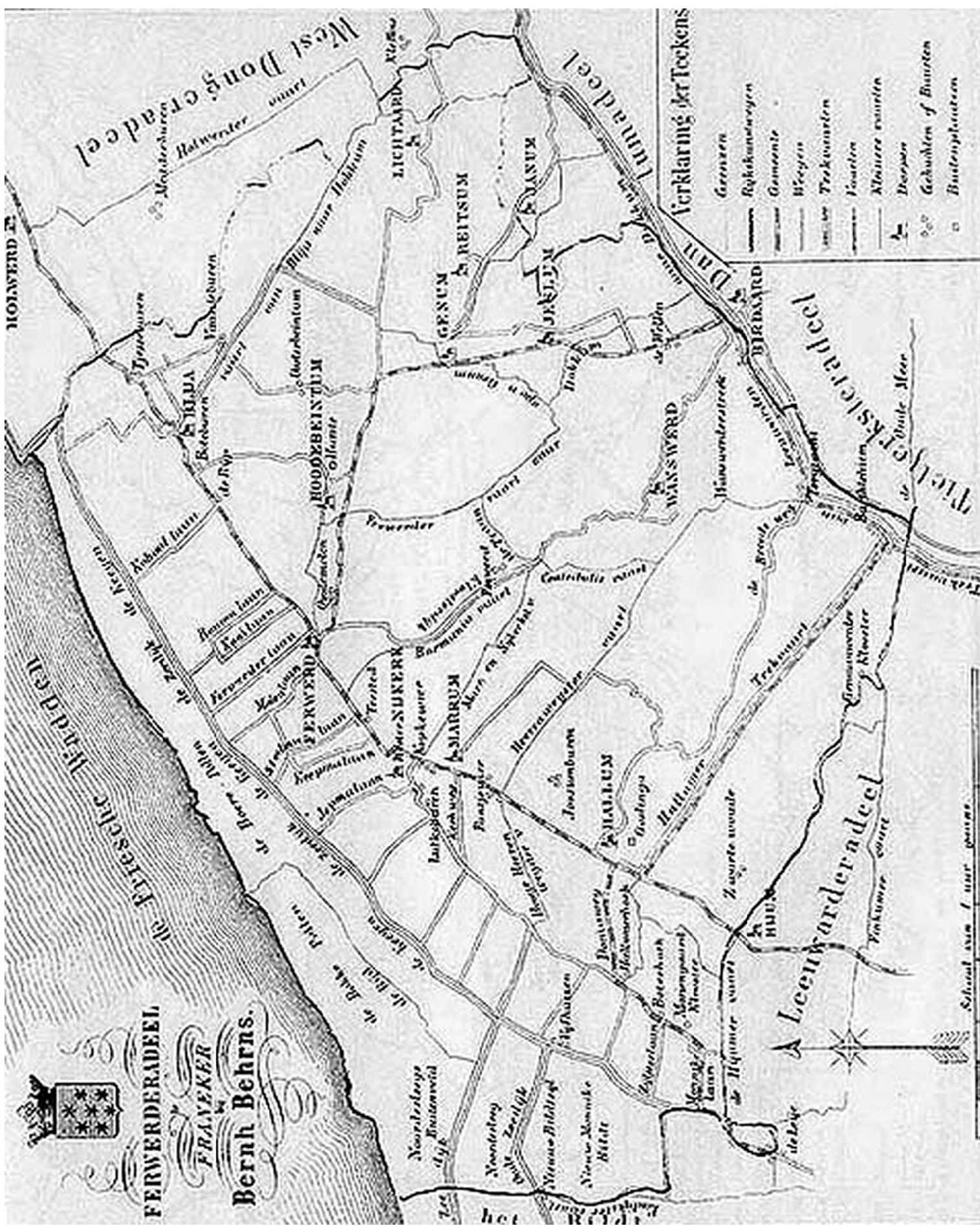
Daniel's surviving three brothers had offspring but their male lines died out in 1851 with the death of Joannis, son of Pieter.

Johannes en Claaske were married for more than 40 years. Johannes died around 1804. Claaske was still alive then. We don't know when she died.

In the next pages you'll find maps of the Netherlands, the province of Friesland and an old map of the county of Ferweradeel, the part of Friesland where most of our ancestors lived and worked.

2. Back to Aschersleben

When Christiany and Daniël left Aschersleben in Eastern Germany (Prussia) in the mid twenties of the 18th century, the Pfeiffers already had been there for 3 generations.

Our first known ancestor, Matthis Pfeiffer, was born in 1599. He came to Aschersleben from the town of Mansfeld (also in Germany) and became the butcher in this medieval little town. Aschersleben lies south of the town of Magdeburg.



The town of Aschersleben dates from 753. This is a view of the town around 1850. In the background St. Stephani's church.

We don't know whom he married, only that he had a son Joachim Pfeiffer, born in 1628, who followed in his father's footsteps as butcher. The date of Matthis's death is unknown.

Joachim married in 1657 in the local St. Stefani church with J. Agatha David-Engels, the orphan daughter of a local militia man. Agatha was then 26 years old. They had one son: Daniël Pfeiffer, born in 1663. His father Joachim died in 1688, 60 years old. His mother became 85 years old and died in 1716.

In the 1600 's and 1700's it is often difficult to find the name of a spouse or a mother. Women and mothers must have counted little in these days. We know for instance when Joachim was baptized, and who were registered as his godfather and godmother, but his own mother's name is mentioned nowhere.

Daniël became the third family butcher in Aschersleben. He was married, but the wedding did not take place in Aschersleben as it is not recorded in the St. Stefani church. We don't know his wife's name either. But they were the parents of the two immigrants to Friesland, Christiany and Daniël. Their father died in their hometown in 1729, after his oldest son left, but Daniël probably left only after his father's death.

Now that we know who our first ancestors were, the next pages provide you with an overview of the first 6 generations of Pfeiffers/Pheiffers.

3. Our Patriarch: Daniël Johannes Pheifer (1757-1826)

Daniël Johannes was born on april 8, 1757 in Nijkerk. In 1787 he married Tjitske Klases Johannes. Tjitske was at that time also 30 years of age and came from Anjum. The lived in Blija, where he worked as a gardener, just like his father. He registered our name as Pheiffer in the new Napoleontic civil registries.

Our name was originally Pfeiffer. But this name with all its f's was too difficult for Dutch farmers. We see throughout the 1700's different spellings written in registers and commercial acts: Pfeiffer, Pfeifer, Pfeijfer, Pfeijpher, Peiffer, Peifer, Pejfer, Pheijfer, Pheiffer, Pheijfer and even more variations. During the reign of emperor Napoleon from France around the beginning of 1800 all citizens had to choose a last name. Daniel Johannes , oldest son of Johannes en Claaske had Pheiffer registered as his last name in 1812. This is the spelling on this website until the 1900's. My great grandfather, Klaas Durks (1859-1923) still used Pheiffer as his last name. But in the beginning of the twentieth century most of the family in Friesland wrote their name as in present days: Pheifer.

Daniel en Tjitske had 2 sons: Johannes Daniëls and Klaas Daniëls, born in resp. 1789 and 1791. From an act of sale we can conclude that the family was prosperous enough to buy their own house in Blija in 1788.

Their son Johannes is the great-great grandfather of most Pheifer's living today. Klaas was the fore father of the Leeuwarden branch of the Pheifer's.

This family lived through a very turbulent age. Following the American and French revolution, republicans (in Dutch called patriots) for a short time took over the Dutch and Frisian government, establishing revolutionary committees.

In Leeuwarden crowds defiled the majestic graves of the hated house of Orange, whose princes ruled the Netherlands as governors. The Oranges who had their birthplace in Leeuwarden were never well liked in the North.

The revolution ended when French troops took over the Netherlands, installing a brother of emperor Napoleon as king. After Napoleons two- time defeat the house of Orange in 1815 returned from their exile in England, establishing themselves then as Kings in a republic that for two hundred and fifty years had refused to have kings. The Netherlands is still a kingdom today

In the next page we will first follow the smallest branch, the descendants of the younger son Klaas - what we in our family called the Leeuwarden branch. Leeuwarden is the capital of Friesland.

4. The offspring of Daniël Johannes Pheiffer's second son: Klaas Daniël

Klaas was born in 1791 in Blija (Frld) and died in 1839. In 1825, when he was 34 years old, he married Nieske Wiebrens Bosma. People in those times often married late, because they had to secure a living, before they started a family. Klaas was an assistant carpenter. The family had 5 children (girls: Tjitske and Klaaske; boys: Wijbren, Daniël and Johannes). As you can see in the chart: only Johannes' line went on to this day. But we know quite a lot of their children and grandchildren, as you can also see in the chart below.

Johannes (1839-1910), an unskilled worker, married Janke Norberhuis in 1863. They had 5 children (1 son: Klaas and 5 girls: Tijtje, Nieske, Hendrikje and Pietje).

His son Klaas (1864 – 1923) seemed to fare better than his father Johannes (whose father died in the year that he was born!). Klaas traded in horses and cattlefeed. But Klaas's life was full of tragedy. He and his wife, Klaaske Kampstra had 5 children. But their oldest son Johannes, died when he was 16 years old. Their second child, Beitske, died a few month after her birth, their fifth child, again a Johannes died after three weeks, while his mother died in his childbirth. So in 1906 he was alone with 2 children: a girl: Beitske and a son: Dirk.

Klaas married again to secure a mother for his children, but he himself left shortly after his marriage and went to work in Germany. He later lived with his daughter Beitske in Leeuwarden, but died deeply suffering after a long illness (cancer).

So only his son Dirk (1903-1987) was left to carry Klaas Daniel's line further into the future. Dirk was a barber in Leeuwarden. That's why they're called the Pheifer's from Leeuwarden on this website.

The twelfth generation (the end of Harke's research) shows 2 of our patriarch's Daniel Johannes descendants through his son Klaas Daniel: *Dirk Jan Pheifer* (born: 1969) and *Harmen Laurens Pheifer* (born: 1986).

5. The family of Daniël Johannes Pheiffer's first son: Johannes Daniël

Johannes was born in 1789, two years before his brother Klaas, also in Blija (Frlid). Johannes was a successful carpenter. In 1814, he married Beitske Bersma, a daughter of a local banker from Holwerd, and moved to Holwerd. Beitske herself ran a shop. Beitske is the first connection to the harbor town of Holwerd, in the region of Dokkum, where most of the family lived. Holwerd is the town where you can take a ferry to the Dutch island of Ameland. And as we shall see: in the years ahead different Pheiffer's would live on the island (even my grandfather did for awhile).

Johannes and Beitske have brought forth most living Pheiffer's today. They had 11 children! 4 Girls: Tjitske, Janke, Klaaske and 7 Boys: Hendrik, Daniel, Durk, Daniel, Sjoerd, Laurens, Leendert and Pieter.

Beitske died during Pieter's birth in 1833. Five year later Johannes married Wintje Pieters Westra, and moved to Akkerwoude (in the wooded area north of Leeuwarden). Johannes died in Holwerd in 1859.



Holwerd in in the 1920's

Only Durk and Leendert carried on the family line of Johannes to today, as far as we know; Dirk in the Netherlands, Leendert in the USA. From this period we have the first photographs!

Of the other children we know the following

- Hendrik was a carpenter in Hollum. Most of his children died early (a son at the age of 3, most daughters in their teens and twenties), while he almost became 80...
- The first Daniël died at the age of 3.
- Of the second Daniël we know he was conscripted in the military. He is supposed to have gone to the Dutch East Indies, where he probably died. But we have no further knowledge of him.

- Sjoerd had a shop in tin articles in Leeuwarden. His only child, son Johannes died at the age of 3.
- Of Laurens we know nothing.
- Pieter died 8 days after his birth.

Durk is mentioned on a stone on the Dutch reformed church in Holwerd, as renovator of the church (he was paid less than 300 dollars for the work).

Durk married Atje Jacobs Wallendal. But 7 years after their union, she already died, at the age of 29. They had 2 sons and 2 daughters. Of Johannes (1852 – 1897) we have no further information. Atze died 1 month after his birth. Here we find the given name Atze for the first time in the family registers, which we'll see many times again until this present day.

Of their daughter Atje we only know whom she married and that she died at age 46. Their other daughter Beitske also died shortly after birth.

Two years after the death of his wife, Durk Johannes married Ybeltje Klazes Heeringa. Ybeltje came from a well-known old Frisian family, Heeringa. And at this point in our story we can show you the first photograph of our ancestors: Dirk Johannes and Ybeltje Klazes. Ybeltje with the typical Frisian headdress with copper ear-irons (sign of wealth!). Ybeltje became quite old (90), my grandparents still knew her!



Ybeltje had a weak hip, so she had to walk with a stick, which she hid, when walking, under her skirt.

Durk and Ybeltje also had four children: son Klaas Durks, my great grandfather (1859-1923), son Atze (died already at the age of 2), daughter Jeltje and son Atze. Their youngest son was the great grandfather of the Eindhoven Pheifer family.

Daughter Jeltje (1863-1954!) I even heard of, as she was still alive after I was born. Jeltje lived on the island of Ameland in the village called Hollum. She had inherited her mother's hip disease, so she also had a walking stick.

Jeltje was married twice, but she didn't have any children. After Durk died, Ybeltje went to live with her on the island. In the Pheifer family picture albums

you will see some pictures of her. Jeltje was a great storyteller, my father told me, she knew everything about the family and kept the old family bible.

So for our story we now go on with Durk's brother Leendert to the American family. After that we will describe the families of Durk's sons Klaas Durks (my great grandfather) and with Atze, forefather of the Eindhoven branch. Eindhoven the town in Holland, where the multinational Philips electronics industries originated.

In the next pages you will find the charts of Durk Johannes. On the website there is a picture album of the Holwerd family.

Leendert was a succesful Builder and Carpenter. He probably worked with his father and older brother on projects. He is remembered in Dokkum (a city in the vicinity of his hometown Holwerd) for building low income-housing. The city named a street after him (Pfeiffer neighborhood), but after a request of my father Harke, the city renamed the street: Pheifer neighborhood. Leendert was also busy socially : he was member of a board of a new Christian school, together with his brother in law Tiete Kuyk, who married his sister Klaaske.

Leendert married Aaltje Wieger de Vries when he was 22 and she only 18, a sign that he at that age already could be a provider. But tragically she already died when she was only 32 in 1867. They had 4 children:

- Johannes: we suppose he went with the family to the USA. But we know little of him.
- Wieger : he emigrated to the US in 1880, before the rest of the family.
- Klaas (Claus) : after the family emigrated he ran a farm in Platte – South Dakota.
- Hendrik (Henry) : we have some information he ended up somewhere in Missouri.
- Jan (John) : we have some information he ended up in the vicinity of Chicago.

Leendert was the first Pheifer who wrote his name with one f. You can see that on his marriage certificate when he married Aaltje.

A couple of months after Aaltje's death, Leendert married Henke Bokkes Venema. Together they had 7 children.

- Aaltje (born in 1867) died shortly after her birth.
- Aaltje (Alice) emigrated with the family to the USA. We have some information she ended up in Minnesota.
- Bokke also died early at the age of 12.
- Rendert must have lived somewhere in the vicinity of Chicago. Most of the old pictures in the pheifer picture albums come from him through and thanks to Cliff Pheifer, great grandchild of Rendert.
- Pieter also only lived for a few month.
- Geeske (Grace) as the information goes ended up in Colorado.
- Beitske lived only for a year.

The family decided to emigrate to America in 1885. The economic circumstances in Europe at that time were very bad. Food prices were very extremely low, so farmers stopped producing, which caused food shortages. Many people were unemployed, there was hunger everywhere. It was the same time as the mass immigration from Ireland took place, because of the potato famine.



Emigrating to America in the 1880 's still went by combined sailing/steam ships

Of his twelve children Leendert left behind 5 children in their graves. He had at that time 4 still living brothers and sisters, whom he would never see again. He and his wife took 6 children with them (Wieger had already left earlier): Klaas, Hendrik, Jan (Aaltjes children) and Aaltje, Rendert and Geeske (Henke's children).

Of Wieger, we have, besides his picture, the information that he had 4 children. Klaas (Claus) had only male descendants through his son Kars (1902-1990), as his other son Leonard never married. For Hendrik (Henry) we have no information. Of Jan (John) we have no information, but he had a family (see picture). Rendert had 3 sons and 2 daughters. Clifford Pheifer is one of his descendants through his son Leonard and grandson Alan.

We have no information how the family how the family came to end up in the Mid-West. Leendert and Henke died and were buried in Orange city Iowa.

In the next pages we show the family of Leendert. There is also a picture album.

8. The Family of Klaas Durks Pheiffer from Dantumawoude

Klaas Durks was born in 1859 in Holwerd and died in 1923 in "Damwâld", the Frisian name for Dantumawoude. Klaas was the last Pheifer who still wrote his name with double f. His life spanned many events from the old European order with the whole Austrian- and Ottoman empires still intact to World war I, where the empires broke up and many new nations came into being. His life saw many new technologies coming into use: electric lighting, cars and airplanes.

Klaas worked as assistant-baker in many places. Why he didn't follow his father and uncles in the buildingtrade, we don't know. But he was entrepreneurial: he had his own bakery in many places, until he settled in Dantumawoude. The area around this village is called the Wouden (the woods). Many Frisians still consider people from the woods as aggressive and dangerous. Dantuma is the name of an old aristocratic family who had large castle like house in this village.

Klaas married Wijske Jans Veenstra when he was 23 and she 21 years old. A year later their son Dirk Klazes was born. Dirk never married and lived with his also unmarried sister Hinke. Dirk, it is told, followed Leenderts family to the USA, but at a later date he returned to Friesland. He sold housewares by bike in Northern Friesland.



Their second son: Jan Klazes did emigrate to the USA, to San Francisco, where he had a bakery. There he married a Dutch immigrant: Albardina van Rijn from Katwijk. Together they successfully started a chicken farm in Sonoma, California, right in the middle of wine-area Napa Valley. John Claude, as he called himself, and Albardina had one daughter, Claudine.

Atze Klazes was their third son. He moved on to Groningen. We will follow his story in the next pages. Atze's sister Hinke, often stayed with the family in Groningen.

Their fourth child was a girl: Attje. She married Egbert de Vries. They were farmers. Her son Berend had a large farm in Turner – Oregon (USA). Berend and his wife Martje were a personal friends of my parents. They visited each other often.

Ybele Pheiffer (named after his grandmother Ybeltje) was the fourth son. Ybe (he hated his given name) was my grandfather. His story is also on a next pages. Daughter Hinke I already mentioned. Klaas en Wietske's last child was also a boy, Jelle, but he died at the age of three.

This side of the Pheifer-family has always been into new things, as soon as they are on the market. Great grandmother Wietske was in the village the first to have a chrystal radio with long wires, which she spent days listening to.

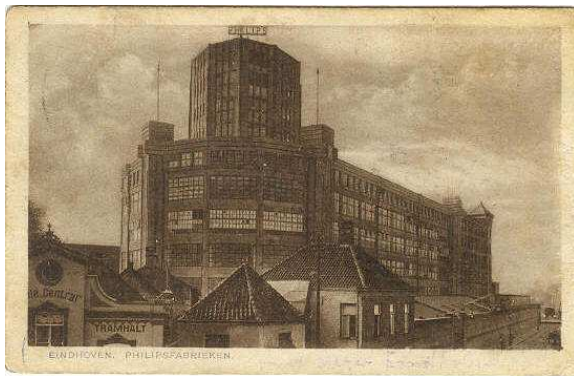

Atze, son of Durk Johannes en Ybeltje Heeringa, brother of Klaas Durks, was born in 1866 in Holwerd. He left Friesland to find work in the South of Holland. Economic conditions around 1880 were better there. He became a supervisor in the Royal Psychiatric Hospital in Eindhoven.

In 1893 he married 30 year old Hendrika Te Winkel. They had 5 children of which the first two boys died shortly after birth. Their other three children, son Dirk Johann Pheifer, daughter Grada Hermina Pheifer and Gerrit Ybele Klazes Pheifer, however survived till a ripe age.

Atze and Hendrika were married for thirty years, when Hendrika died. After some time Atze then married Dina Sophia Koole, but she died only half a year later. A couple of years later he married Anna Sehstedt. With Anna he lived for another 14 years, but she died just before the second World war in 1940. It must have been quite a life experience for Atze, to bury three wives! Atze himself tragically died in 1944 during a bombardment of Eindhoven, an important industrial town.



Eindhoven, the town where the giant multinational Philips electronics company was founded, starting with the production of electric light. Here you see Eindhoven's famous light tower.

Dirk Johann (1899), Atze's oldest son, was a technical designer for Philips industries. He was a gifted painter and often stayed with his Aunt Jeltje on the island of Ameland to paint landscapes. He must have been musical, as he also built violins. He married Cornelia Koedam. They had two children: Atze en Corrie. Dirk Johann died in 1962 after a traffic accident.

Of Atze Durks other children: Grada Hermina married Johannes van Breen (they had 3 children). Gerrit had one daughter through his marriage with Wilhelmina van der Meeren.

As Corrie never married, the family line continued only through Atze, Dirk Johann's son. His son, also called Atze (1924 - 1997), was a chemical engineer in a Delft blue factory. Atze's marriage with Hannie Gimberg brought forth one son and two daughters: Eddo Atze Pheifer (1963). Eddo's sister Joan is a notary in Bilthoven. His sister Karin is a speech therapist.

Atze worked for more than 40 years for the city as a gardener. He must have had some of the older Pheifer- genes, for early Pheifer's in Friesland also were mostly gardener! From Atze and Akke came forth the extended branch of the Groninger Pheifer's.

Klaas (1913-1986), their first born, also was a gardener for the city. In 1935 he married Jantje Albers and together they had 4 children: 3 girls (Antje-Akke, Akke en Jantje) and one boy: Atze (1936). Their son Atze and his wife Jantje had 2 sons: Klaas (1962), Jack (1964) and one daughter: Jolanda (1973). His grandchildren already include at least one grandson: Roy (1991).

Wietske, Atze Klazes daughter, married A.J. van Wolde. As far as we know they have one daughter, Akke

Dirk (1916-?), Atze Klazes second son, was a bit of an exception in the family: he married Fennechien Boels, they had 4 sons: Henk, Atze, Detmer and Dirk. But they divorced and Dirk left for Australia, where he married again. From this marriage another son came forth, Ronald (Blue) Pheifer (1955). Blue has two sons: Christopher (1986) and Matthew (1993) and one daughter: Mikayla (1990).

Ybe Pheifer (1893-1983) studied to be a schoolteacher, wanted to be a carpenter, but became a baker. In 1913 he was called up as a conscript soldier. Holland stood watch, while World War I raged across Belgium and France. He told me about being endlessly bored in the half underground forts around the Dutch water defense works, forts which were wet and humid day and night. The defense strategy was that parts of Holland would be inundated if we became part of the war and defend the country through a line of forts across Holland behind the water.

In 1918 Ybe married Griet Harkes van der Meulen. She was a special woman. She was born on a flat bottom sailing barge, which carried trade along the Frisian waterways. When there was no wind her mother and all the children had to pull the ship with its cargo. Pictures of her at 18 years show a tall heavy muscled woman. . She was literally a strong woman, who dominated her husband all her life. At the end of her life she survived open cancer for years. She seemed to be unbreakable.



A family, like my grandmother Griet, working and living on a sailing barge, which often had to be pulled to its next destination

Ybe and Griet had 4 boys: Klaas, Harke, Douwe and Dirk. For the first 3 boys, Griet had their future planned: Klaas as Teacher (which he did become), Harke as Church minister (but he chose for the car mechanical trade – he just loved car's), Douwe as Baker (but he became a professional musician in the Northern Dutch Philharmonic Orchestra). In the thirties they were relatively rich. The family already had a car, my father his own motorcycle.

Ybe and Griet retired in 1956. But my grandfather couldn't sit still, so he worked as employee in different bakery's until he was almost 80! Griet joined her brother a few times on a seafaring coaster, as ship cook, making trips to Scandinavia. She was endlessly curious about the world, wanting to make trips when ever she could. The last ten years they lived in Sneek near their son's Harke and Dirk.

Their son Klaas married Grietje Coops, they had two children: daughter Josien and son Ebo Regnerus. Klaas died already when he was 53. And tragically his 18 year old son died a year later in a sailing accident in France. Josien and her mother were suddenly totally bereft. Josien has two daughters.

Harke, my father, has his own page in this booklet, as he gathered all the family information.

Douwe married Catharina van der Werf. But a year later Catharina died in childbirth, however Catharinus (Rien) their son survived! Later Douwe married Ina Jeuring. They had two son's together: Ibo and Bert. Bert died early (at 49) of an uncurable disease. Douwe died in 2009.

Rien Pheifer has two daughters of which one, Anniek, is a wellknown actress. Ibo has a son (Cas Ybe) and a daughter. Bert has 3 children, 2 daughters and one son: Steven Daniël.

Ybe and Griet's youngest son, Dirk (Dick) married Alie Pot. Dick ran his own gas stations in Sneek and Bolsward. Dick and Alie have two sons, Ibo and Ronald. Ronald never married. Ibo has three daughters and one son (Dirk Jan).

Harke Pheifer was born in 1920 in Rottevalle (Frl'd). He was the second son of Ybe Pheifer (1893-1983) en Grietje van der Meulen (1893-1986). He had an older brother Klaas (1918-1972) and 2 younger brothers, Douwe (1924-2009) and Dirk (1933). As a boy Harke worked in the bakery of his dad and was a motorcycle enthusiast.

Harke went to tradeschool in Leeuwarden to become a car mechanic. In the second World War he worked in a garage, but later had to hide from the German occupiers to avoid forced labor in Germany. In 1944 he married Janke Keuning from Drachten. Janke was a daughter of Jacob Keuning and Aaltje Boonstra. Jacob worked in a milk factory.

Harke en Janke had 3 children, Ebo Rudolf (1945), Alie Ingrid (1947-2013) en Jacob Robert (1950). After the War in 1946 Harke took over a garage in Sneek (Frl'd). First he sold any vehicle that could run (there were few cars in Holland after the War). Later he started selling Ford cars. In 1958 he took over as Volkswagen/Audi dealer for Sneek en Bolsward.

Harke was an avid traveler. As soon as inexpensive airline tickets became available in the early sixties, he and Janke started travelling all over the world. They went to the USA and Canada 5- 6 times, also to visit family members who had emigrated after the War.

Harke was also always socially active, outside his business. In the car business employers unions. As a city council member and loco-mayor in Sneek and as the chairman of the local business association.

Harke retired in 1985 (65 years old) and then started a new life as a Golf retiree. He played Golf till a year before his death . He died at the end of 2006, his wife Janke died in 2010.

During his retirement he spent almost 15 years on gathering the family information, which is now in this booklet.

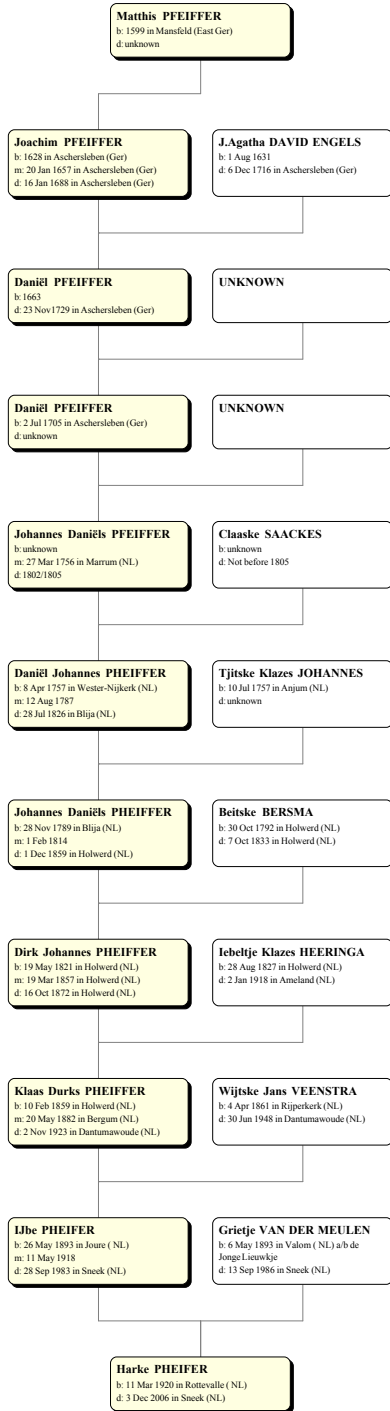
